Choose schools and apply for admission (Application fee waivers might be available)

**Dates on Campus Websites** 

To be eligible for a Cal Grant, the California Student Aid Commission must receive your school-verified GPA. Call 1-888-CA-GRANT (1-888-224-7268) with questions. The state financial aid priority deadline is March 2.

\*If you're planning to attend a California Community College, <mark>September 2</mark> is your last chance to apply for a Cal Grant.
